- 100% Dornfelder: most popular German red wine grape. Cross of Helfensteiner x Heroldrebe. First grown in 1955.
- Appellation: Rheinhessen / Germany  
Loam and clay soil.
- Heat maceration. Fermentation in stainless steel. One filtration prior to bottling. Ageing in stainless steel.
- Cherry red color, aromatic scent of cherries and blackberries. Soft tannins, smooth fruity finish.

Enjoy it slightly chilled with chips, cheese or as a companion of your main course of pasta or meat.
